#### Items to donate:

- Small electronics and appliances: clock radios, coffee makers, toaster ovens, Instant Pots, bread makers, slow cookers, etc.
- Outdoor and Sports gear: camping, skiing, hockey, baseball, croquet sets, boules, etc.
- Tools: hand tools, small power tools like saws, drills, etc.
- Wall art
- Kitchen essentials: dishes, cutlery, utensils, serving dishes and platters.
- Linens: sheets, pillowcases, bathroom towels, tea towels, tablecloths, cloth napkins, runners, table toppers, doilies, etc.
- Books: children's books; adult novels
